

This training is eligible for SME portfolio. You can finance a part of the program using subsidies from the SME portfolio.

Which companies?

To qualify for the SME portfolio subsidies, the company must be a small or medium enterprise (less than 250 employees and annual limited turnover), from private sector whose operating headquarters is located in the Flemish Region. Furthermore, the company must have an acceptable activity. You will find the list of acceptable sectors (using the NACE code) on the website <u>http://www.kmo-portefeuille.be</u>

The ASBL and large enterprises, for example, are not taken into account in subsidies from the SME portfolio.

What amounts?

The following principles apply:

- Small enterprises: limit of 10.000€/year and maximum percentage of aid of 40%
- Medium enterprises: limit of 15.000€/year and maximum percentage of aid of 30%

What is the process?

Ask your subsidies online via <u>www.kmo-portefeuille.be</u>.The site automatically approves your request. This should always be done within fourteen days after the start of training.
